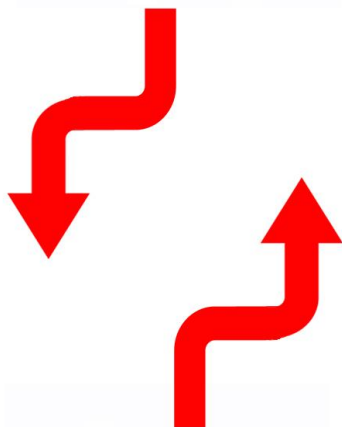


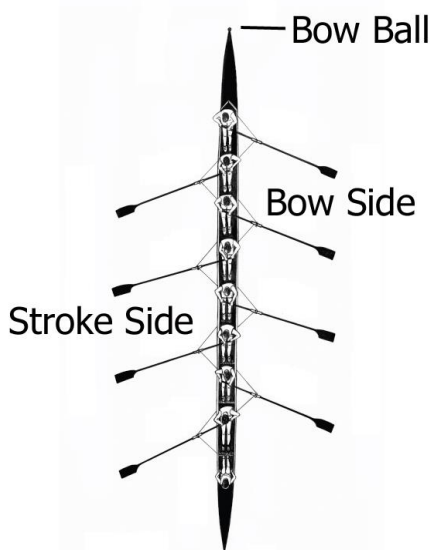
Preventing Collisions When Rowing



To prevent a head on collision when two rowing shells are approaching one another on the same course, each should alter their course to **STARBOARD**. For the coxswain, that means steering to the **RIGHT**.



Because rowers are generally facing backwards, that means pulling harder on the **STROKE SIDE** (right hand).



It's the opposite to the road rules and applies to all water craft (motor boats, yachts, jet ski's etc)
